A short Account of
the Roman, or Civil Law.

The Roman or Civil Law, taken in
the largest Sense, was comprehended
under the following Heads, or Titles.

1. Lex Civilis Papieniana - a Collection
of 4 parts of the Roman Laws, digested
into one Volume by P. Papius in the
reign of Tiberius Augustus, A. D. 100.
2. Lex XII Tabularum - a body of Laws
drawn up by the Decemviri, out of the
Grecian Laws, & their own Charges, in the
Year 503.
3. Lex Civilis - or the Range of the Law
containing the Interpretations of the
Roman Lawyers, occasioned by the course.

Our Research Groups bring together researchers with shared research interests.


About the group




BISHOP HURD'S COMMONPLACE BOOKS


