Implemented during 2014/15


Undertook data entry of all lists before handing over ownership to academics






We wanted data entry to be quick, and to roll out a completely populated system








Students undertook a significant



Instructions

The instructions below take you through the process of adding items to the Aspire resource list system. Following these instructions, add the items that are on the Answer Sheet to the resource list that is open on the browser in front of you: "TEST LIST - [your name]"

- You have 30 minutes to complete this test.
- · You may ask for clarification on these instructions at any time.
- · Do not worry if you do not complete the exercise in the allotted time.

Adding books & ebooks from Library Search

- 1. Go to librarysearch.worc.ac.uk and search for the item you want to add. Searching tips:
 - Search for the book or article title and put "" around it, e.g. "the theatres of George Devine".
 - Use the REFINE YOUR SEARCH options on the results screen to filter results. Top tip

 use 'Full Text Online' for anything electronic, or use CONTENT TYPE (book, journal, etc) to specify whether you're searching for a book or journal.
- On the list of results screen, add the title you want by clicking 'Add to My Bookmarks' (in the browser toolbar) – see screenshot
- 3. A 'Bookmark to Reading List' link will appear by each title. Click on the link next to the item


It all went well! We recruited 6 students





We kept a very close eye on Resource List Assistants at first








Hiring students isn't without its challenges

It's a leap of faith - will students' initial enthusiasm be sustained?


