The result is a disparate collection of works by artists who, in all probability, would never otherwise exhibit together.

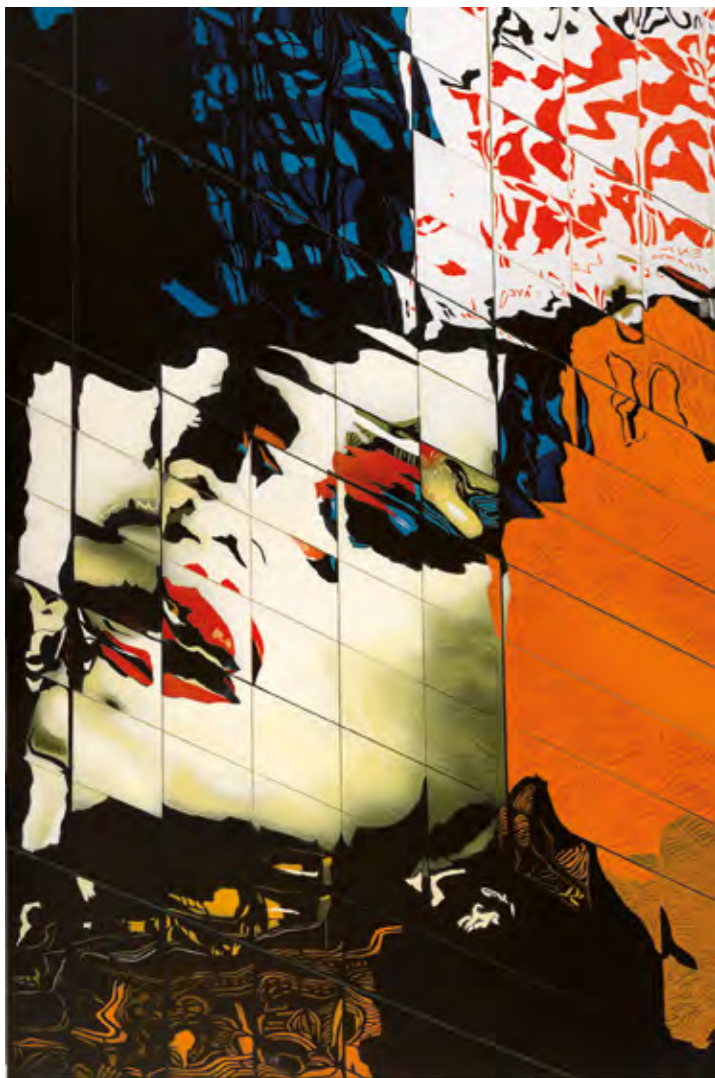
But they all have qualities I would promote to young artists:

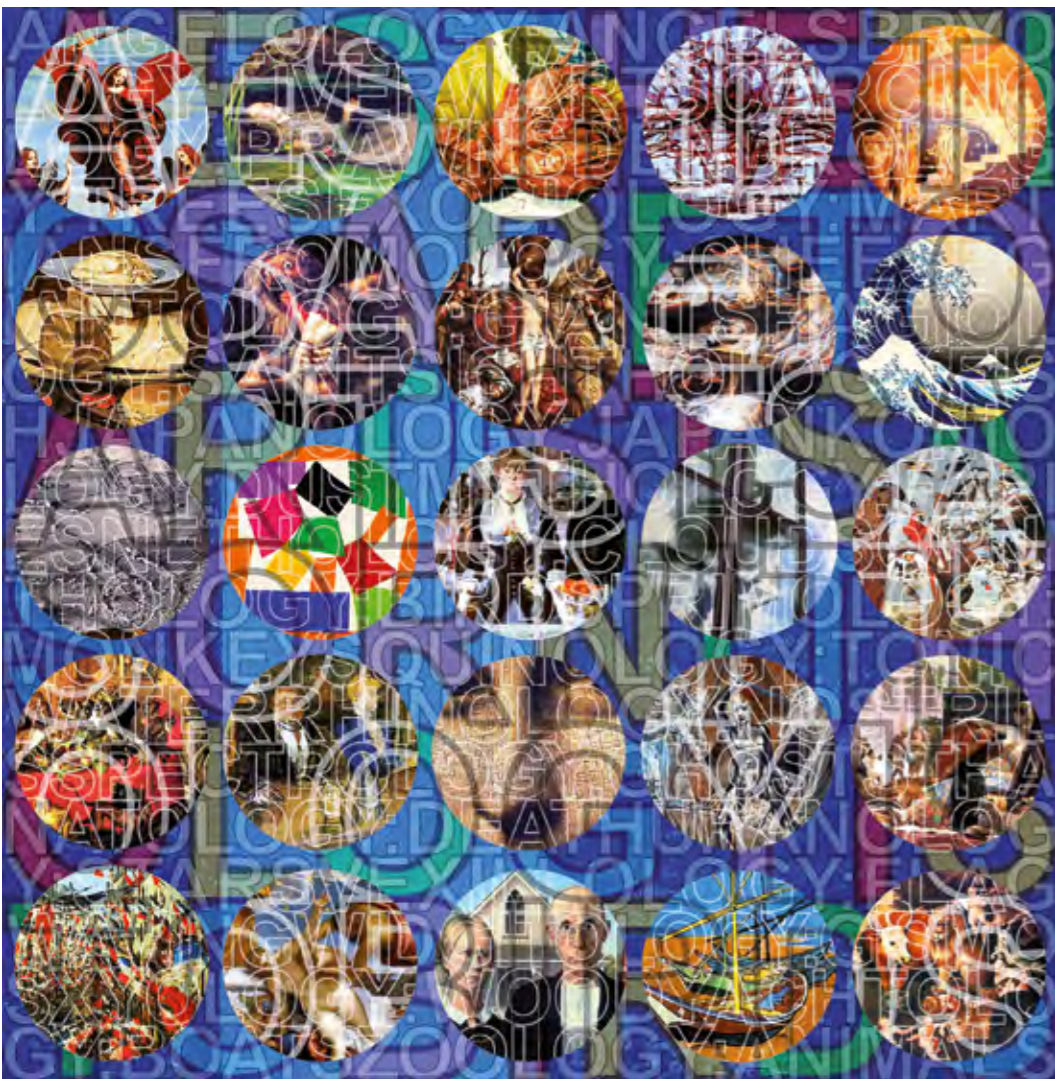

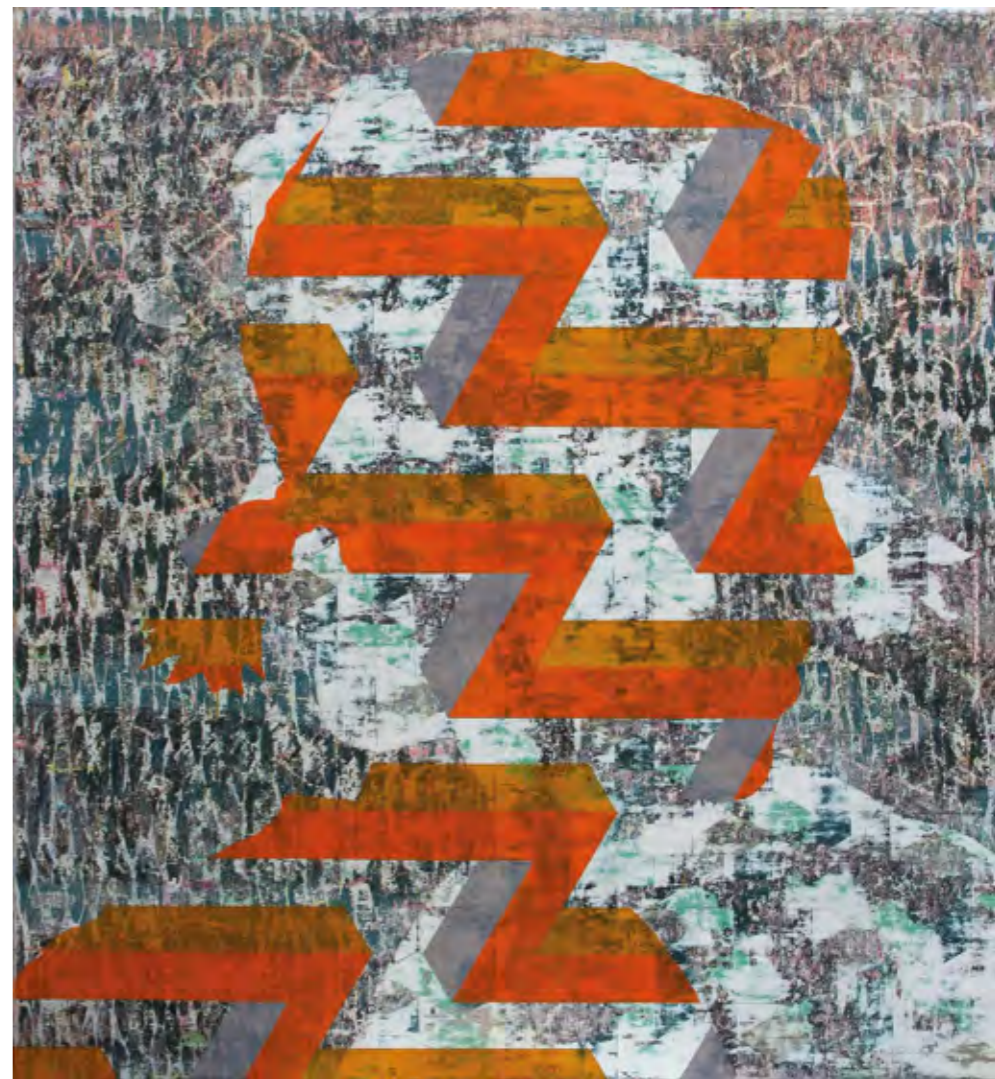

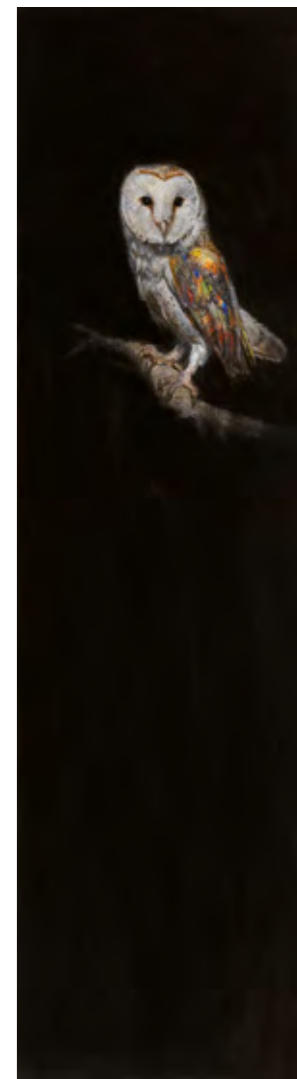

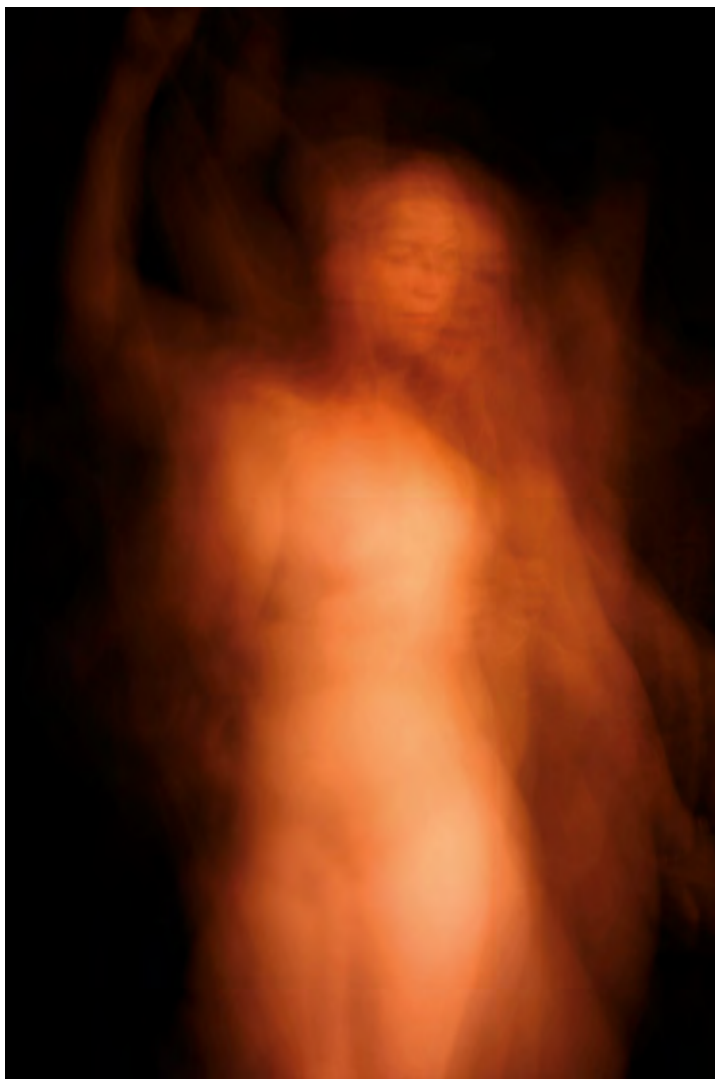

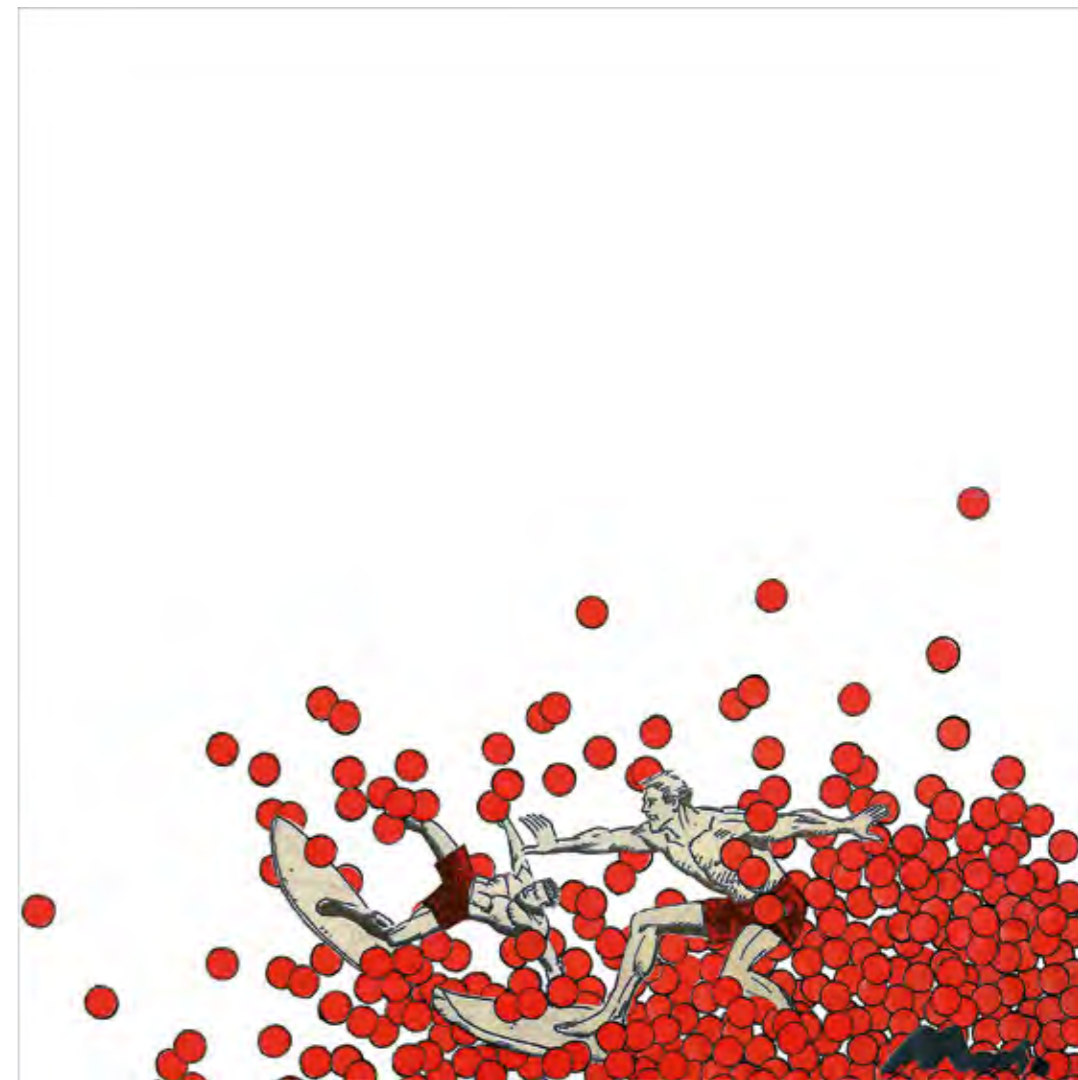

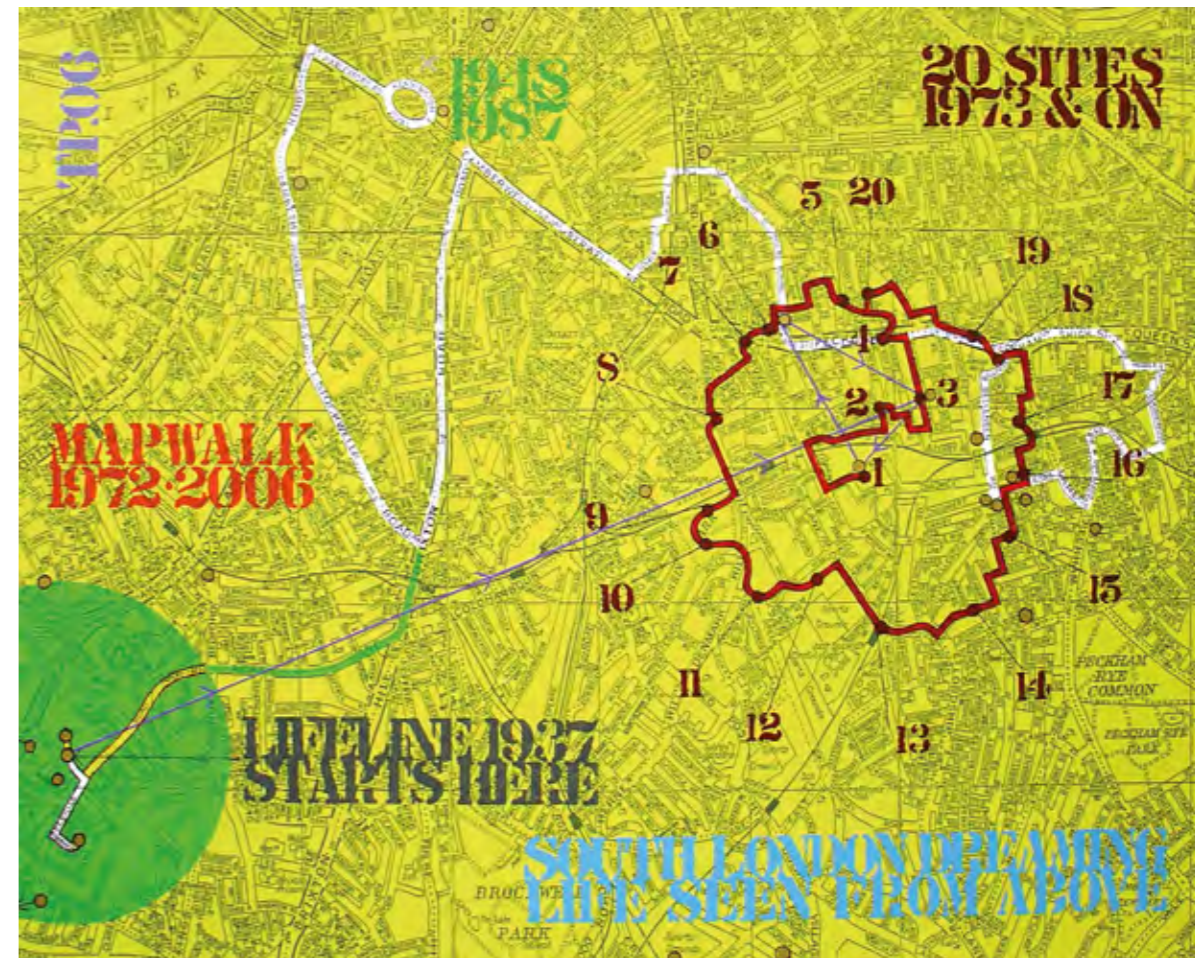

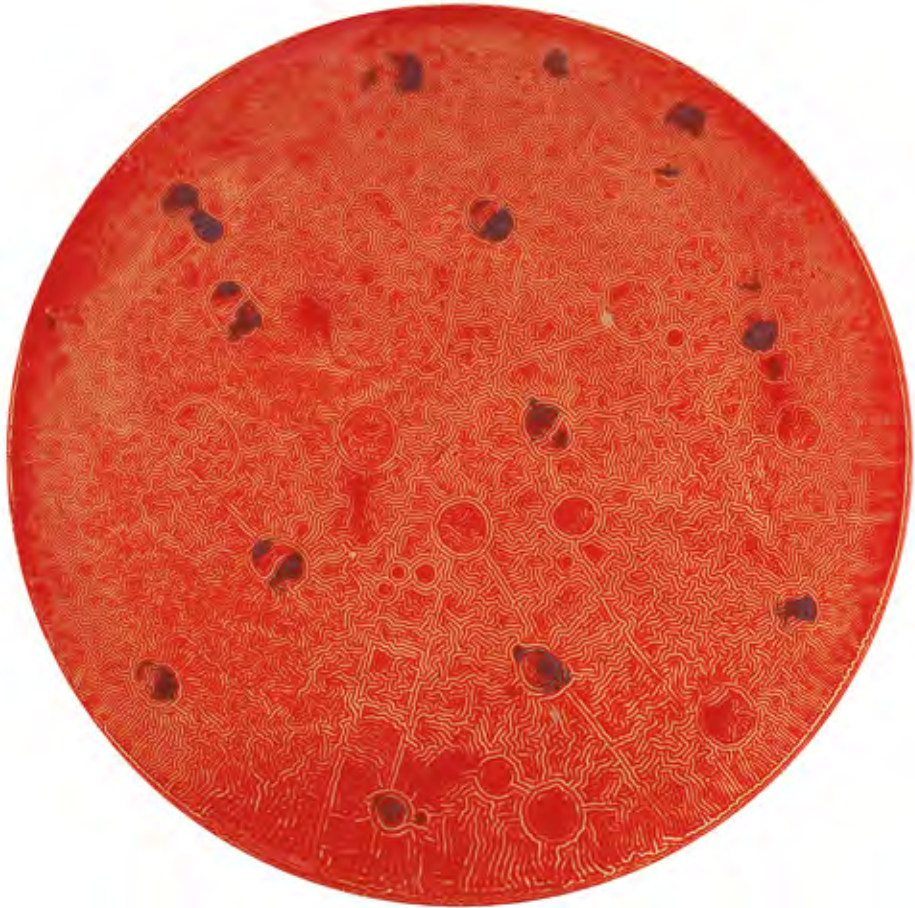
